

Let's Ride by Lee B

This month's recommendation could be a long ride for some. The destination is to go see the Tunkhannock Creek Viaduct. Alternately known as the Tunkhannock Viaduct and the Nicholson Bridge. The bridge is in Nicholson, PA and can be seen from US-11. The bridge is 2,375 feet long and 34 feet wide. It is 240 feet above stream level and 300 feet above bedrock. There are twelve arches with ten being 180 feet across and two being 100 feet across, one at each end of the bridge that are totally buried in the landfill. https://www.nicholsonheritage.org/tunkhannock-creek-viaduct/


