Safety Corner

Roger Deevers is the Safety Officer from Tucson, AZ. For several years now, he has been writing safety articles for the Retreads in the Tucson area.

Mistakes experienced riders make:

- Sometimes things considered to be mistakes can be wrong choices. How safe an individual wants to be is up to that individual. Greater risks are taken through less or inappropriate riding gear. The less that is worn, the greater the risk of sustaining an injury becomes. We often see riders wearing only a

T shirt, jeans and maybe a helmet that would be barely classified as such. When flesh meets pavement, pavement always comes out as the winner.

- Space awareness and vision is crucial to avoiding mistakes. Intersection and cornering are two locations where mishaps often occur. Vehicle drivers aren't looking for motorcycles. As evidence they are crashing into each other. Doing a head check proceeding through intersections, changing lanes and merging reduces the possibility of making a mistake.
- Over estimating one's riding abilities. If you think you're good, you aren't. Complacency and over confidence allows for a lax attitude. A safe rider is always self-critical and mentally admonishing himself when making a mistake.
- Choosing to take the bike when pressed for time is a huge mistake. Being in a hurry to an appointment can make one take chances that you otherwise wouldn't. Select alternative transportation to avoid stress and making a mistake.
- Predicting danger ahead, from behind, and in the immediate surroundings. The abundance of distractions like road signs and advertisements takes attention away from focus on what is most important to you which is You!

Avoiding mistakes provides for a much safer and more relaxing ride. Ride safe, Roger
